



KNOW THE SIGNS

Warning Signs of Uterine Cancer

None of these mean you have cancer. All of them mean you deserve to be checked. Bring this to your doctor.

- ✓ **Any bleeding after menopause**
The single most important sign. It is never normal, and always deserves evaluation.
- ✓ **Bleeding or spotting between periods**
Anything outside your normal cycle.
- ✓ **Unusually heavy or long periods**
A change from what is normal for you.
- ✓ **Pelvic pain or pressure**
Discomfort that persists and does not resolve.
- ✓ **Unusual or watery discharge**
Especially if it is new or blood-tinged.

Symptoms are not screening.

Waiting for a warning sign is not the same as being checked for one. If you notice any of these, call your doctor and ask to be evaluated.
